

## Brave Arts Community Agreement

\*required for registration and continued participation in all Brave Arts programming

These are our current COVID-19 safety requirements as of **January 18, 2021**.

We understand that with vaccine progress and other measures that our requirements will likely change and may even be able to be reduced based on Town of Weston Board of Health, federal and state mandates and CDC recommendations. As we approach summer 2021 communication will be sent to all registered families with further updates as they are made available.

1. I understand that my child will be **required to wear a 2-ply or (ideally) 3-ply face covering** (mask) during all indoor and outdoor activities except during meals, water breaks and mask breaks where the participant can be outside and socially distanced. If my child is unable to wear a mask for 6 hours, I will reach out to the directors of Brave Arts at [braveartssummer@gmail.com](mailto:braveartssummer@gmail.com) to discuss this matter **prior to registration**. I also understand that physical distancing measures will be put in place whenever possible and will be particularly prioritized when indoors.

I understand that if my child is unwilling or unable to wear a mask or practice physical distancing during the day they will be dismissed from Brave Arts for the day or week depending on the circumstances. This action is not punitive towards the child, but to protect the safety of themselves and other participants.

2. I understand that weather permitting **Brave Arts sessions will be held outdoors or under a tent for as much of the day as possible**. Any limited indoor time will require ventilation from open windows and doors as well as portable HEPA fan/filter systems.

I also understand that my child will need to be able to **properly practice hand hygiene (20 seconds with soap and water)** and will be required to hand wash before/after all meals and activities. If soap and water is not available, hand sanitizer will always be available.

3. I understand that while Brave Arts has historically held a musical revue performance every Friday that medium to large audience gatherings may not be possible in summer 2021. I also understand that the curriculum and structure of Brave Arts with regards to singing may need to be adjusted for safety measures.

4. I understand that my child will be **assigned to one to two counselors** and will eat lunch, socially distanced and outside with their **assigned small group (5 participants)** to reduce risk of spread. While we will do our best to accommodate friends, the priority will be given to the same households and age groups in order to protect during unmasked times. These groups are at the discretion of Brave Arts staff.

5. I understand that as of January 18, 2021 Brave Arts will limit all day sessions to **25 participants** per session plus 5-6 staff members. Any decision to adjust or reduce the registration capacity will be communicated to currently registered participants.

6. I understand that parents/guardians will not be permitted to exit their vehicles during drop-off without permission and a mask must be worn during pick-up and drop-off. I understand that all participants will need to fill out a MedBot survey or similar program to **report any symptoms, travel and/or possible or known exposure**. This will need to be filled out as honestly and accurately as possible within 1-hour of drop-off. I understand that I will need to pick up my child(ren) immediately if staff or child report any symptoms. I understand that if my child displays symptoms or has a known exposure to COVID-19 then

they cannot return to the session and refund (not including the deposit) will be discussed with directors Keith Greenfield and Sarah Clancy.

7. I understand that other participants will have various levels of risk outside of Brave Arts hours, including possible exposure at other activities. As a member of the Brave Arts community **I will commit to adhering to all Massachusetts State health requirements, regarding out of state and country travel, physical distancing, public gatherings, face-coverings and guidelines for youth sports and activities.** In order to be able to safely hold Brave Arts this summer, we request that all families also commit to only gathering with other households and activities that also require face coverings be worn while practicing social distancing, hand hygiene and contact tracing if a case or symptoms are detected.

I understand that if my child and family and "bubble" are found in violation of any of this agreement that I will be contacted by the directors to discuss further steps and this may result in dismissal.

8. I will commit to **contact tracing with Brave Arts.** If I am contacted that my child(ren) has/have been exposed to a possible or known case then I will adhere to all current safety measures with regards to quarantining and testing. I will alert Brave Arts staff immediately if my child(ren) displays symptoms or has exposure to a positive or suspected case.

9. Beginning at least 10 days prior and throughout the Brave Arts session **I will prioritize the health and safety of the Brave Arts community** when making decisions regarding social engagements, including playdates, sleepovers, and family/parent-related get-togethers. I understand that as the COVID-19 situation evolves, I may also need to **produce a negative PCR test** for my child(ren) prior to the start of the session. More info to follow.

10. And finally, I understand that **Brave Arts staff will be in frequent contact via email and phone** to keep our families safe this summer. I will promptly respond and report to all information requested and required including future correspondence with required medical and waiver forms that have not yet been provided to me. I understand with regards to this waiver and registration that further information will be required and that late documentation or signatures may result in dismissal from Brave Arts 2021.

In submitting this agreement I have read all of the above requirements and guidelines and understand that prior to summer 2021 I will need to submit all required medical forms provided by Brave Arts staff to all families as well as sign additional liability and risk waivers.
